

AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY CONCEALED CARRY UNIT (NM DPS CCU)

Beginning May 1, 2023, fingerprint services for concealed carry will now be provided by a new vendor called **IDEMIA**. In addition to the change in fingerprint fees, there will also be a change in the application fee paid to the New Mexico Department of Public Safety (NMDPS).

Beginning, May 1, 2023, the application fee will be \$100.00 for each new application as authorized in the New Mexico Concealed Handgun Carry Act.

Renewal applications remain \$75.00 with no additional fees to process the fingerprints on file.

There are no application fees payable to NMDPS for active military, veterans, or law enforcement.

INITIAL APPLICATION FEE INFO FOR CIVILIANS:

- \$100 fee collected for application by NM DPS Concealed Carry Unit
- \$59 fee paid to IDEMIA for initial fingerprints ORI: NM920200Z

INITIAL APPLICATION FEE INFO FOR MILITARY/VETERANS (Discharged within prior 20 years) and Law Enforcement

- No application fee
- \$23 fee paid to IDEMIA for initial fingerprints ORI: NM920272Z

NOTE: Any applicant using the Military/Law Enforcement ORI must provide proof of service to the department. No refunds will be given for applicants using the wrong ORI and this may cause delays in processing.

RENEWAL APPLICATION FEE INFO FOR CIVILIANS:

- \$75 collected by renewal application by CCU.
- No additional fingerprint fees.

NOTE: There are no renewal fees for Military/Veterans/Law Enforcement
